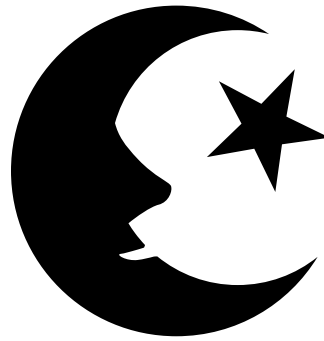


# Glitter Body Art Kit™



## INSTRUCTIONS

*All the tools and supplies you need are included in this kit:*

- 3 - 4 g (.14 oz.) jars of glitter (Lavender, Turquoise, Silver)
- 15 ml.(1/2 oz.) adhesive
- .5 mm applicator tip
- 6 self-adhesive stencils
- 2 Cotton swabs

*Instructions and design ideas*

- If you are prone to allergies or have sensitive skin, it is a good idea to do a test design and wait a day to see if any reaction occurs.
- For best results, read through all directions and tips before starting.
- Avoid inhalation and eye contact.

*Directions for drawing designs directly onto skin:*

1. Remove white cap from adhesive bottle and twist fine applicator tip onto nib.
2. Gently squeeze the bottle and draw a thin line of adhesive onto skin.
3. Let the adhesive dry a little until clear but tacky.
4. Pick up a little of the glitter on your fingertip and dab lightly over the adhesive. Apply the glitter in this way until the design is covered.
5. Brush off excess glitter.

*Directions for using stencils:*

1. Peel stencil off of the backing paper and apply to skin surface where you would like the design.
2. Squirt a little of the adhesive onto a cotton swab and dab a light coating of the adhesive onto the skin in the stencil area.
3. Let the adhesive dry a little until clear but tacky.
4. Pick up a little of the glitter on your fingertip and dab lightly over the adhesive. Apply the glitter in this way until the design is covered.
5. Remove the stencil.
6. Brush off excess glitter.

*Another way to apply adhesive: Rubber stamps!*

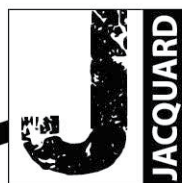
1. Brayer or brush a thin layer of adhesive onto a smooth surface.
2. Dab a rubber stamp into the adhesive and press onto skin.
3. Let adhesive dry and apply glitter as described before.



*Tips:*

- The glitter tattoo can last on skin for several days. For easier removal, apply lotion to skin before applying adhesive.

*Tips* cont:

- Test the applicator flow on a paper towel before starting.
- Start with a simple design and add complexity.
- If doing larger designs, work in sections applying some adhesive, then glitter before moving on to the next section.
- Turn mistakes into part of the design.
- Applying lotion to hands and fingertips will help to pick up a little of the glitter.
- A small cosmetic or paint brush is helpful in brushing excess glitter off of the design.
- The best results come from a light and even application of both the adhesive and glitter.
- For multiple colors in a single design, apply adhesive and glitter in one color before moving on to the next color.
- When finished, rinse design area with water to remove any glitter that is not part of the design.
- Baby oil will aide in removal of the adhesive.
